

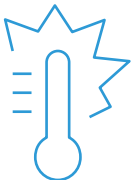


SOLVING INDOOR AIR QUALITY ISSUES



HEALTHY AIRFLOW THROUGHOUT YOUR BUILDING

Sealing your ducts blocks out all the dust, dirt and allergens, providing fresh air to all points of the ductwork system, including the end of the runs which can often suffer from insufficient air flow when the ducts are leaking.



CONTROL HUMIDITY AND AVOID MOLD GROWTH

Leaky return ducts pull in moisture from damp shafts, crawl spaces, or basements which usually leads to mold growth. Sealing those returns will block that unconditioned air from entering the system and eliminate the threat of mold growth inside your ducts.



CREATE A CLEANER ENVIRONMENT

Stop dust and dirt from being blasted all over your building. It's being sucked into your ductwork through cracks and holes in unconditioned spaces (shafts, crawlspaces, ceilings, behind walls, etc.)
